### **Planned demonstrator - CELINE Equipment Provider Demonstrator**

In the CELINE application, Petals is extended and configured to achieve Enterprise Information Integration (EII) between business applications and data sources in the business case of an Equipment Provider.

The CELINE application showcases scenarii involving the management of equipment lifecycle, where equipment is provided to technical teams according to their objectives and recovered afterwards for maintenance.

Some technical problems addressed by this demonstrator are :

- Connecting to applications using CSV files as service calls
- Connecting to database services
- Achieving distributed routing using the JMS transport feature
